RATIONALE

Mobile phones can be used inappropriately. Effective management of student use of mobile phones will reduce loss or damage and reduce possible invasion of privacy.

AIM

To manage appropriate use of mobile phones by students.

IMPLEMENTATION

- Students are not to bring personal mobile phones to school unless written permission has been granted by the Principal
- The school does not accept responsibility for lost or damaged student mobile phones
- Students who have permission to have a mobile phone at school must leave it switched off and leave it with their classroom teacher or the office
- Students are not permitted to use the camera function on a mobile phone
- Mobile phones are not to be taken on camps and excursions
- If written permission is granted, the conditions of use are to be documented
- If the conditions applied in the written permission are not fulfilled, permission may be revoked
